# ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

On 1 January 2017 a new version of the SCC Arbitration Rules entered into force. While maintaining continuity of what could be described as the essence of an SCC arbitration, the new SCC Arbitration Rules introduce a number of noteworthy innovations aimed at efficiency of arbitral proceedings, including summary procedure, joinder of third parties and handling of multiple claims in a single arbitration. The purpose of this seminar is to discuss these cost and time saving mechanisms that can make arbitration more user-friendly.
