3. How to strike a balance between the protection of investments and the host country's right to regulate?
4. To what extent are conciliation and mediation efficient in the settlement of investor-state disputes?

At the close of the conference, BCDR-AAA and the SCC will host a cocktail reception, followed by a screening of *The Quiet Triumph* – presented by the SCC.
