Inger Brattne is Senior Legal Director and Lead Counsel at Pfizer, one of the world's largest research-based pharmaceutical companies, and member of the Pfizer International Legal Leadership Team. She is based in Stockholm, Sweden.

Her previous positions at Pfizer include Legal Director Pfizer Sweden and Legal Lead for the Mid-Size markets 1 in Europe, where she led the legal support to the Pfizer affiliates in that region. Inger joined Pfizer following the merger with Pharmacia in 2003 as Associate General Counsel, Nordic Countries. Prior to joining Pfizer, she was legal counsel at Akzo Nobel, following a position as in-house counsel at Astra AB (now Astra Zeneca). Before joining the private sector, Inger was hovrättsfiskal at the Svea Appellate Court, Stockholm. Inger received her law degree in 1979 from the University of Lund, Sweden, following studies in political science at Colorado College, Colorado, and research in international law at the Max Planck Institute for Intellectual Property Law, Munich, and the London School of Economics, London.

Inger holds various corporate and other board positions within Pfizer, including on the EU Pfizer Legal Alliance, and is the chief editor of newsPfLAsh, the Pfizer Europe Legal newsletter. She is a board member of Juristföreningen in Sweden, and the former president of the Swedish Company Lawyers' Association (BJF). As a founder/director, she has also worked extensively on mentorship and diversity issues in various boards within and outside Pfizer, including in BJF and Pfizer's ExPAND and WOC programs.
