**Challenges to investment treaty arbitration awards
in the Svea Court of Appeal**



Joel Dahlquist Cullborg has recently defended a doctoral dissertation in international law at Uppsala University. The topic of his research is the use of commercial arbitration rules in investment treaty disputes. In a lunch discussion with Professor Eric De Brabandere, he will focus on one specific part of this research: challenges to investment treaty arbitration awards in the Svea Court of Appeal. There has been a number of such cases, in which parties have asked the Court to set aside treaty-based arbitral awards. How has the court approached these cases? Is there, or should there be, a difference between awards based on investment treaties and awards based on contracts? What lessons can be learned from the experience?
