



The Swedish Arbitration Association Scholarship for the Master in International Commercial Arbitration Law Program

The Swedish Arbitration Association (SAA) has donated a full-tuition scholarship for a student to participate in the Master in International Commercial Arbitration Law program (ICAL program) at Stockholm University for the 2015-2016 academic year.



The ICAL program is a globally recognized and top-ranked LL.M program specialized in international arbitration. Every year about 30 students from around the world participate in the program and learn both theory and practice of arbitration from prominent academics, arbitrators, and other practitioners.

Stockholm is a leading venue for international arbitration, home of the Arbitration Institute of the Stockholm Chamber of Commerce, and hosts a thriving commercial and arbitration legal community which supports and collaborates with the ICAL program. During the past decade, the ICAL program has established a wide network of alumni who actively work in arbitration and commercial law in key firms, companies and organizations around the globe. By participating in the ICAL program, students also join the ICAL global network.

- **Who can apply for the scholarship?**

Non EU/EEA citizens holding a law degree from a university from a non-EU/EEA country. (EU/EEA citizens are exempt from paying tuition for the ICAL program).

- **When to apply for the scholarship?**

From 2 March 2015 until 15 April 2015.

Documents submitted for admission to the program will be used for assessing the scholarship applications.
