**THE SWEDISH ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP  
FOR THE MASTER IN INTERNATIONAL COMMERCIAL ARBITRATION LAW PROGRAM**

The Swedish Arbitration Association (SAA) is a non-profit organization that promotes the practice and study of arbitration in Sweden. Through its range of activities and its extensive international network it provides a platform for expanding and exchanging knowledge and experience for improving arbitration practice and enhancing Sweden as an international leader in the field.

The SAA offers one full-tuition scholarship for the academic year 2015-2016 to one law graduate from a non-EU/EEA country to participate in the Master of Laws in International Commercial Arbitration Law program at Stockholm University (“the Master program”).

**General information on the application process**

**1. Eligible students**

Non-EU/EEA citizens holding a law degree from a university of non-EU/EEA country. See list of EU/EEA countries [here](#).

At the time of application applicants must hold a university diploma in laws or an equivalent law degree of at least 120 (180 ECTS) credit points (a three-year-degree). Applicants must also meet the English language requirements for admission to the Master program.

**2. How to apply**

Complete and submit the application form electronically. There is no need to provide any supporting documents with the application form, as we will receive the supporting documents directly from our Admissions Department.

Scholarship applicants must also separately apply to the Master of Laws in International Commercial Arbitration Law program through the University admissions website, [www.universityadmissions.se](http://www.universityadmissions.se). Applications may be made from **2 March 2015 until 15 April 2015**

The deadline for scholarship applications is **15 April 2015**. A complete application form should be sent to [master@juridicum.su.se](mailto:master@juridicum.su.se)

### **3. Application process**

Applications will be reviewed upon receipt and shortlisted candidates will be considered throughout Spring 2015. Successful scholarship applicants will be contacted in Spring 2015.

The scholarship will be awarded to the most exceptional applicant based on merits.

Due to the volume of applications and interest that we receive we are unable to notify all applicants of the result of their applications or to provide feedback on individual applications. Applicants who do not receive an answer from Stockholm University by the end of June 2015, shall assume that their scholarship application has been unsuccessful.

The scholarship covers the tuition fee for the 2015/2016 academic year, is valid only for that academic year and cannot be deferred.

Applicants that wish to delay their studies must reapply for the scholarship.
