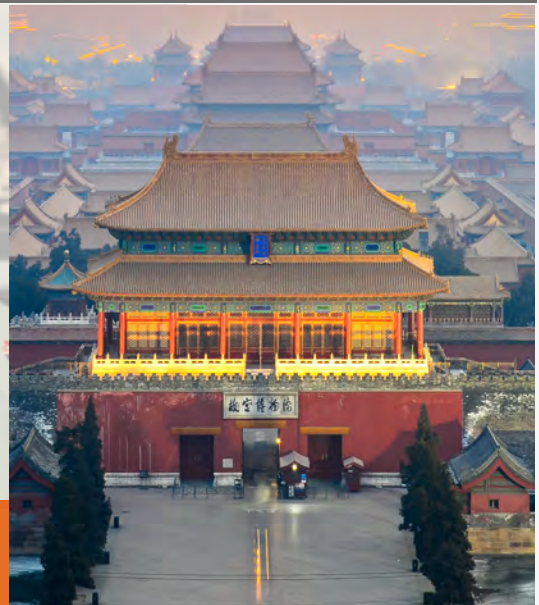

The SCC continues to strengthen and innovate its procedures by making a comprehensive revision of its rules. In September 2014, the SCC Board appointed a Committee, chaired by Jakob Ragnwaldh (Mannheimer Swartling), with the task to revise the SCC Rules. The work of the Committee has resulted in a proposal for revised Arbitration Rules and revised Rules for Expedited Arbitrations. The proposal is available [HERE](#).

- summary procedure
- multi-party/multi-contract disputes
- investment treaty arbitration; and
